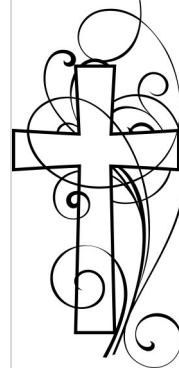

Pastor's Letter



Dear Parishioners,

Do you feel spiritually inspired? Do you want to do something great for the parish? Do you want to do something great for God? What is it that God has for you to do in this life?

Yes, maybe it is praying for others, at Mass or at home or offering a rosary for a particular intention. Maybe it is doing something, participating in some way that gives glory to God. Giving “glory to God” means recognizing that God is at work in the world. This may be in creation or in a changed life.

Every single time that Matthew Kelly’s father would drop him off at a sporting event or practice, which he had a lot of because he loved to play sports, his father would say to him, “listen to your coach.” Having heard the line for the ten thousandth time Matthew asked his father why he always offered this encouragement. His father told him that nobody achieves excellence at anything without coaching. Being the best that you can be at anything does not happen without coaching.

If we look around ourselves we see that this is true in the world. We see the help of coaches in sports, in learning (tutors), in parenting and in any areas of life that people seek to improve.

How often does this happen in our lives as Catholics? When did that thought (or something like it) last cross your mind? I have had people tell me that they want to know Jesus, or that they want to pray or that they would like to be at peace. These desires tell us that we are on the road of desire to becoming an “excellent Catholic.” Remember Mother Teresa’s line, “Doesn’t God want us all to be saints?”

On page 137 of Matthew Kelly’s *Resisting Happiness* he notes that, “Nobody achieves excellence at anything without coaching,” and then encourages us to “Seek out a spiritual coach.”

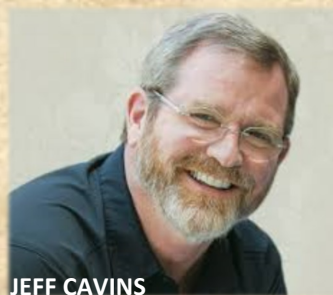


As always the weekend of the bazaar we will also be asking for our wonderful bakers to turn on those ovens and make your specialties for our baked goods table.
