

Stations of the Cross Fridays in Lent 7:00 p.m. at St. Philip Neri Church



My dear Parishioners,

The Gospel of John presents the coming of Jesus as a moment of crisis for the world. "Crisis" comes from Greek and means a time of judgment or of decision. Today, John's Gospel puts us squarely in crisis, a time in which we must make a choice. Today, prior to the 2nd Vatican Council, we would have begun "Passiontide," the two weeks prior to Easter in which we were called to focus intensely on the sufferings of Christ. But Vatican II refocused the whole of Lent on the Passion and death of Christ, so this period within Lent called Passiontide was dropped, but the readings were not changed. What we were once called to do we are still called to do, that is, look directly at the Passion and Death of Christ.

The choice of Christ to enter into suffering allows John to show us what it means to allow the law of God to be written on our hearts. The Law had been first written on stone tablets but now is written on our hearts. Now the Law can be perfectly internalized, so every choice would be to do everything in a way that expressed our love for God.

Last Sunday we heard that "God so loved 'the world' that He gave his only Son." We are told by Jesus that "now is the time of judgment on 'this world.'" It is time to make a decision. Do we choose to remain in the world, or do we choose to live with Christ? Will we allow God to write His law on our hearts, or do we resist?

Jesus' death on the cross reveals what happens when any of us choose this world over God's: suffering and death. We must move God's law off of the stone tablets and let it enter our hearts in a way that we can never ignore it.
