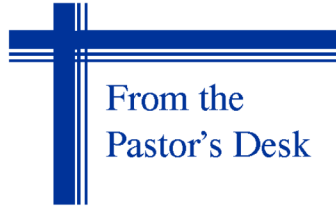


MOTHER'S DAY SPIRITUAL BOUQUETS

From the
Pastor's Desk

My dear Parishioners,

Today we hear a short section from the first letter of Saint John and we can almost feel his wonder and enthusiasm! “See what love the Father has bestowed on us,” he writes. Believers are worthy of being called children of God, and even more is going to be revealed to them. They shall actually become like Him when the time of revelation comes. They will see God as he truly is. Our faith tells us that this promise is made to all believers. We, too, are the children—the sons and daughters—of God.

One of the greatest privileges of living the Christian life is that we can embrace both the “already” and the “not yet” of our identity as children of God. Because we are already children of God *now*, we can enjoy the blessings of having such a devoted and caring Father. And when we face trials or feel abandoned, we can fix our hearts on heaven, where we will finally see our Father face-to-face and where he will wipe away every tear from our eyes and set us free from everything that weighs us down.

Make this the theme of your prayer today. You have a Father who loves you not because of how good you are or what you do but simply because you are His. You have a Father who likes to give you good gifts; a Father who cares about you so much that he has counted every hair on your head. You have a Father who walks with you through every storm, always reminding you of his promises and his provision.
