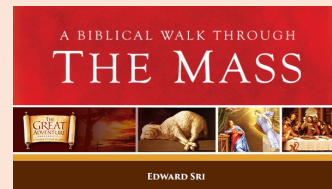

My dear Parishioners,

Saint John in today's Gospel shares what is called Jesus' "high priestly prayer." Commentators describe a series of reports where Jesus render to God an account of his saving mission. Along with his reports, Jesus includes petitions to God for those from whom he will soon depart.

As Jesus concludes his mission of revealing God and the way and will of God to his disciples in order that they may become his witnesses to the world.

Jesus petitions the Father for:

- 1) protection from the world.
- 2) A oneness among their members such as what Jesus shared with God.
- 3) A complete and fulfilling joy that derives from the good news that Jesus has spoken to them.
- 4) Sanctity or holiness that those who belong to Jesus are consecrated—that is, set apart—for the special service of the truth.

Contemporary followers of Christ can find courage and strength in the fact that Jesus continues to pray this prayer for us and to petition God for all we need to continue his mission until he comes to take us home.

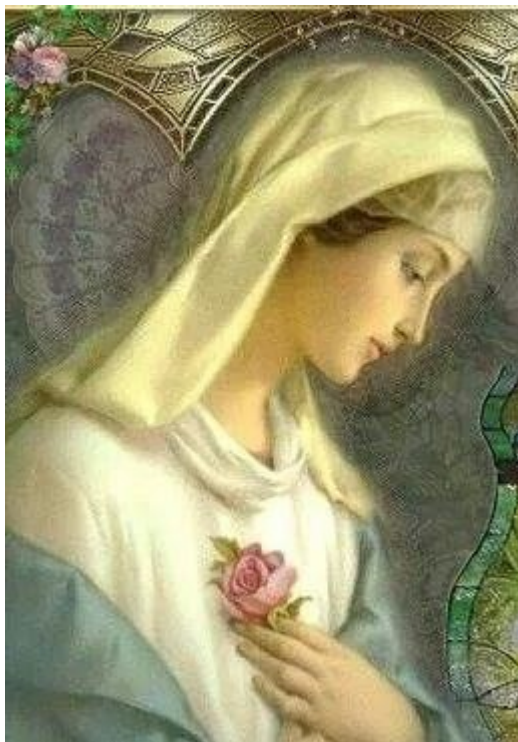

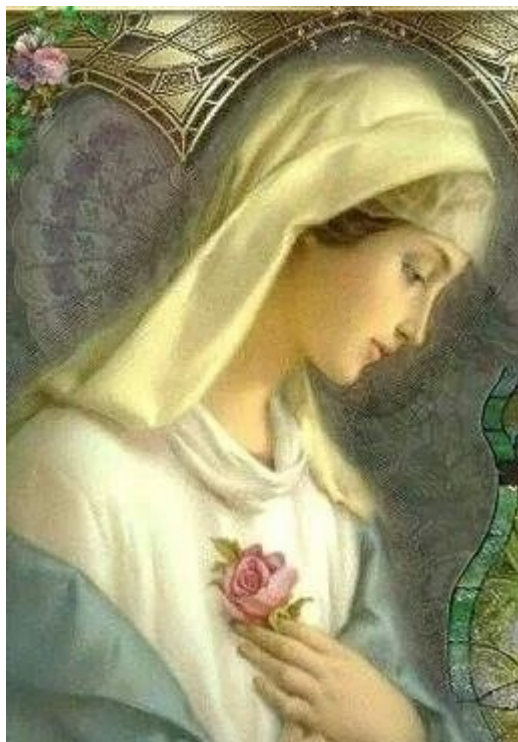
