

As you may know, I suffered two heart attacks this year but the doctors told me that there is a chance that I will recover enough to return to St. Philip as your weekend guest—God willing.



My dear Parishioners,

In today's Gospel, Jesus commands us to love one another as he has loved us. In his letter to the Corinthians, the Apostle Paul writes that there are three things, "faith, hope and love. And the greatest of these is love." It seems that there is nothing more important to us than love. Love is mentioned over 600 times in one translation of the Bible. If you go to the Internet and type in the word "love" you'll get nearly 2 trillion responses.

Love comes in four flavors: Generic: "I love a good cup of coffee." Eros: "I love you, my darling." Philos: "I love all my friends." Agape: "I love you unconditionally." Agape is the highest form of love, where we expect nothing in return. It's like the love of a parent for a child or the love God has for us.

Love is the message of the Easter season, and has been emphasized repeatedly in the sacred texts with the hope that it would be echoed and found welcome in our minds and our hearts. God loves, and we who are the beloved of God are to love one another. This is our lifelong commitment to each other. As St. Augustine of Hippo once said, "One loving heart sets another on fire."
