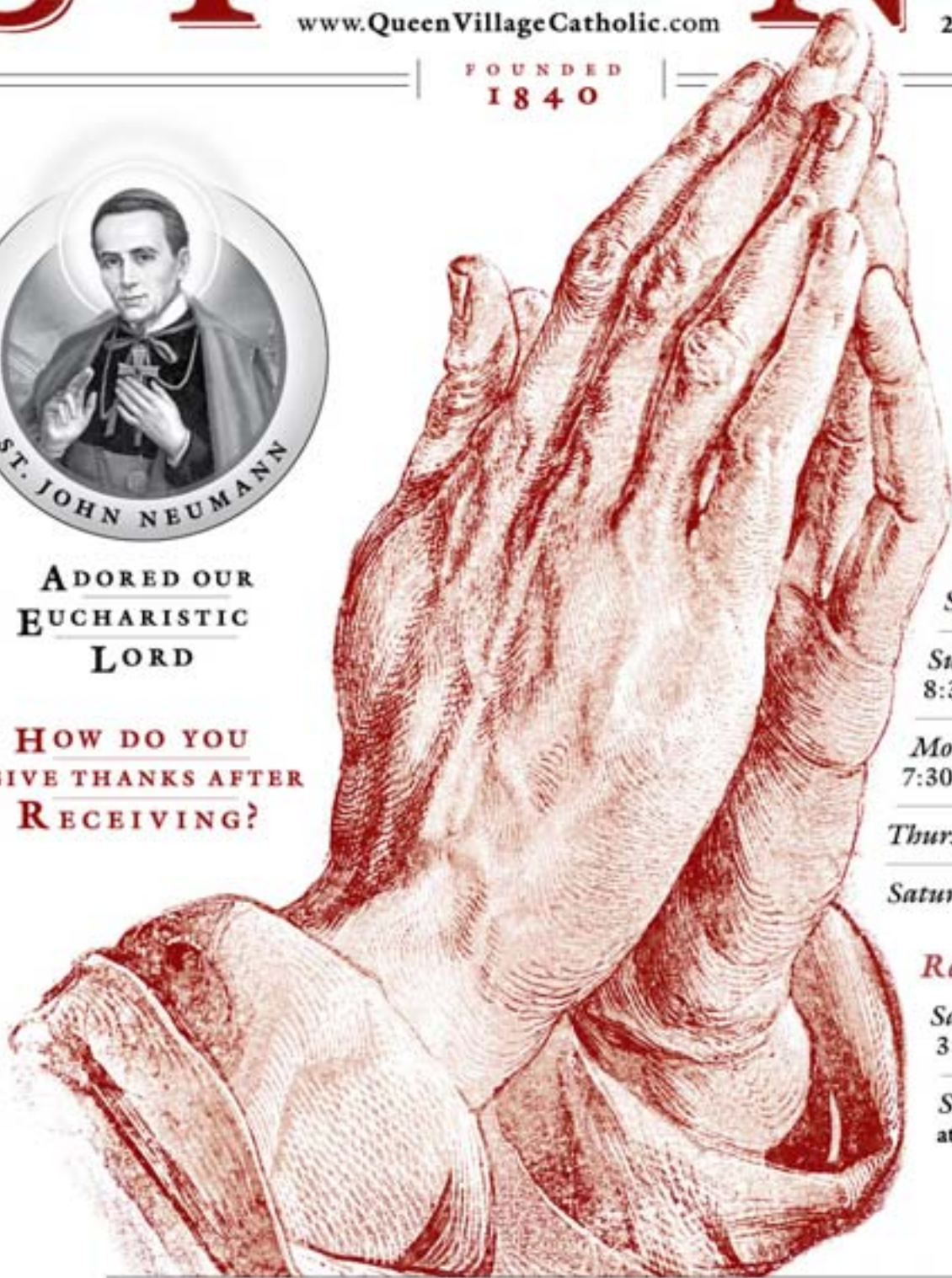

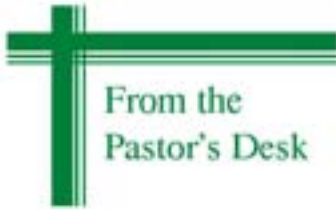

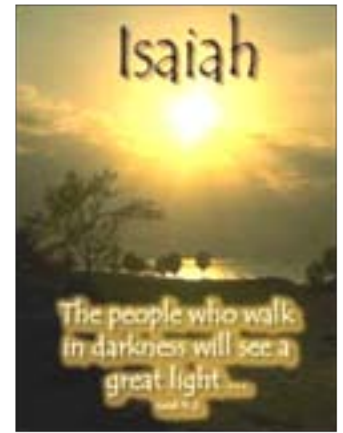

My dear Parishioners,

A Hindu poet writing on death described the moment powerfully: “Death is not extinguishing the light; it is putting out the lamp because dawn has come.”



In today’s Gospel, the dawn comes to Blind Bartimaeus, ending his long night of darkness. Bartimaeus didn’t sit quietly and wait for things to happen. He boldly called out to Jesus.

In our personal, daily quest for the light, we are inspired by Bartimaeus’ persistent call to the ever-passing Jesus. We are challenged to snuff out our lamps because the dawn has come. Paraphrasing Isaiah 9:2, “We are a people who have walked in darkness, but by discovering Jesus, we have found a great light.”
