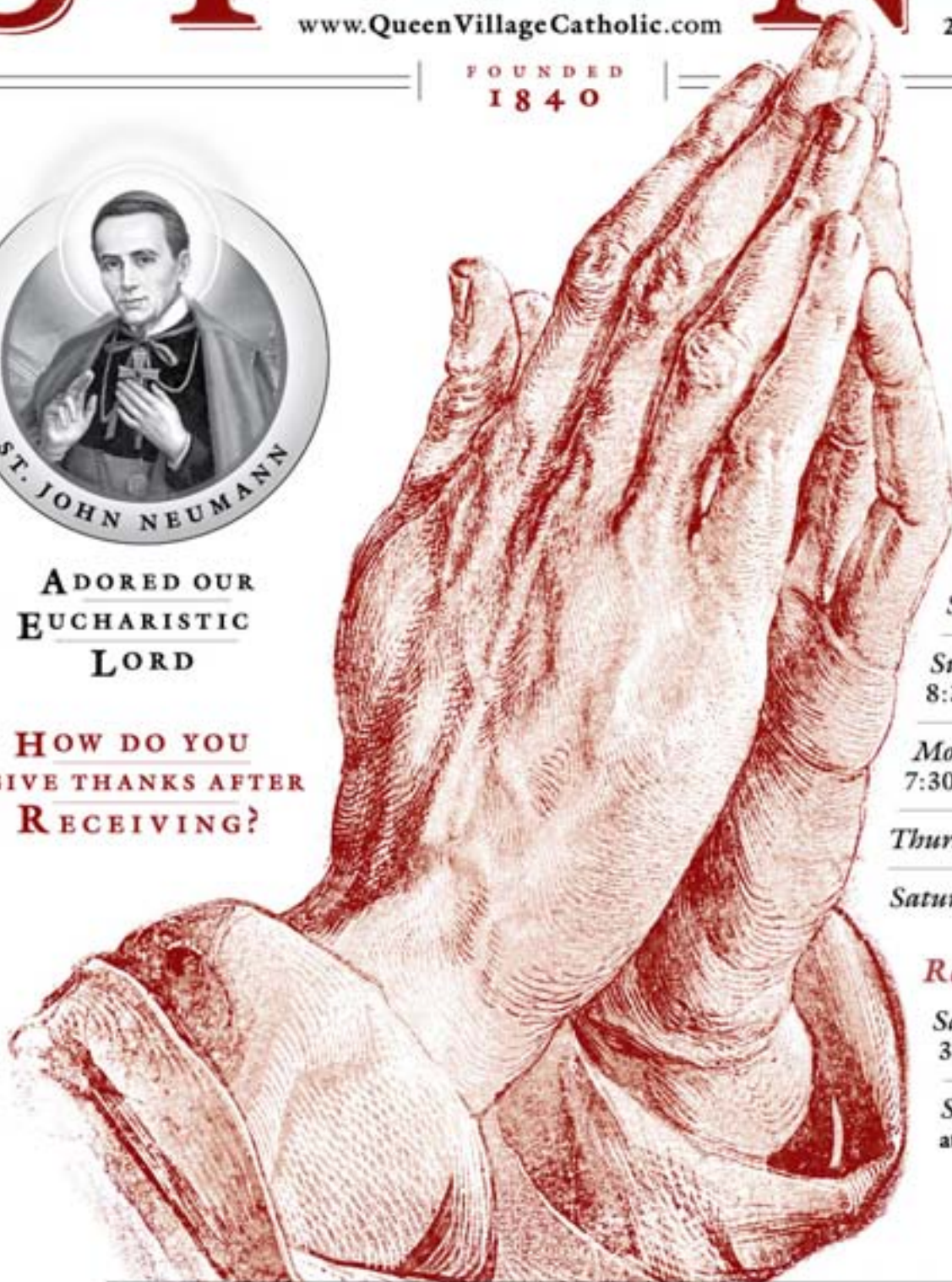

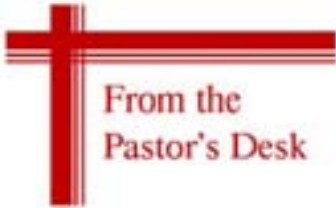

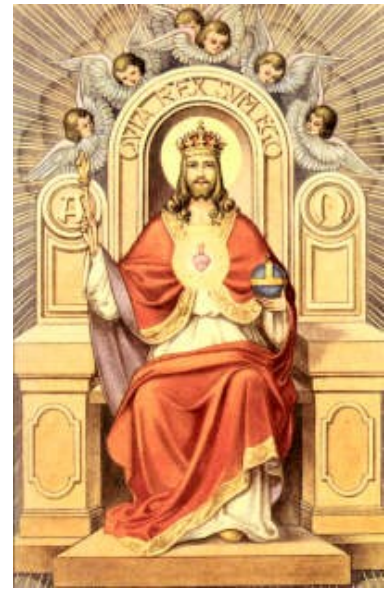


My dear Parishioners,

In today's final gospel of the liturgical year, we come to the moment when Jesus declares that His kingdom is not of this world.

In 1925, Pope Pius XI instituted this special Sunday as the Feast of Christ the King. In 1969 Pope Paul gave the celebration a new title: Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. He also gave it the highest rank, that of solemnity.

After a year of teaching, our Gospel stories end with the stunning realization that Jesus is much more than a local Jewish leader. He is, in fact, the king of then entire universe and the king of the incomprehensible vastness of endless space and endless time.



Today, may our prayer be that the fruits of his reign may abound upon the earth. May our Lord Jesus Christ rule over our world in peace, and fill our hearts and households with the power of His love.
