


My dear Parishioners,

Today the first reading from the Prophet Daniel reminds us of one of the most important aspects of the end of time— the blessing of immortality and eternal union with God. Notice that, in the ancient author's vision, both the wicked and the just will be raised up to life. For their part, the wicked shall reap the everlasting harvest of horror and disgrace that their evil ways have sown. The just, on the other hand, will

shine like the stars forever. These just ones were people whose faith inspired others to lead good lives; these are the ones "who lead the many to Justice."

Saint Oscar Romero, Archbishop of El Salvador, was one of these just ones whose valiant dedication to securing the rights and freedom of others made him a shining light in our midst. Martyred for his beliefs on March 10, 1980, Romero now shines like the stars forever. On the very day he was assassinated, Romero spoke about his death and his belief in everlasting life. "I have often been threatened with death...as a Christian I don't believe in death without resurrection. If they kill me, I will rise again in the Salvadoran people...I give my life for those I love and even for



those who are going to kill me...Even now I offer my blood to God for the redemption and resurrection of El Salvador...If God accepts the sacrifice of my life, may my blood be the seed of liberty and the sign that hope may soon become a reality." (from *The Violence of Love*)

Like Romero and all those other just ones now shining like the stars forever, believers in Jesus and in the good news of salvation are called to give their lives so that God's justice may prevail. We may not be called to bleed, but we are called to pour out our energies without reservation. Then, when the time of our departure from this life arrives— a time no one knows except God— we shall be prepared to shine with all the just ones forever.
