## My dear Parishioners,

I believe that each human being has a vision of a new world, a world different from the one which we're actually living, a world free from the pain and frustrations we're daily forced to endure. Many of us forget that the historical Jesus also had a dream of a better world, different from the first third of the first-century Palestinian environment in which he lived. It's clear from his Gospel emphasis on the

"Love one another." This is the message of today's gospel. It's simple. It's difficult. It's impossible. But God desires us to be so good at loving that those who do not know him will say, "How do they do that?" That's a big responsibility, and yet it is the only way we will create a world where all may be happy.
