


Sacraments of Initiation for Children

My Dear Parishioners,

Two very beautiful and disarmingly simple images feed our faith and challenge the quality of our discipleship as we gather today for worship. Salt and light are set before us as symbols of who we are to be in the world. If we take Jesus at his word, then his charge, "You are the salt of the earth; you are the light of the world," implies that we are to live in such a manner that we impart the services or characteristics of salt and light to those around us.

St. Teresa of Avila, 15th-century Spanish mystic and Carmelite nun, gave us these words, put to song by John Michael Talbot in his "St Theresa's Prayer";

Christ has no Body now but yours
No hands, no feet on earth but yours
Yours are the eyes through which He looks
Compassion on this world
Yours are the feet with which He walks to do good
Yours are the hands with which He blesses all the world
Yours are the hands, yours are the feet
Yours are the eyes, you are His body.

St. Teresa is so right. Our hands, eyes and feet can bless this world. We don't need special qualifications. We don't need to do monumental things. A hand held, a grief shared, a joy celebrated, a prayer said—that is enough. We are all saints in the making.
