Just in time for Lent (which begins February 26), we are presented this Sunday with readings that challenge us mightily. In our first reading, God calls us to be holy as God is holy. In the Gospel, Jesus calls us to be perfect as the Father is perfect. Are these goals even possible?

Saint Paul points to one answer: “Do you not know that you are the Temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?
