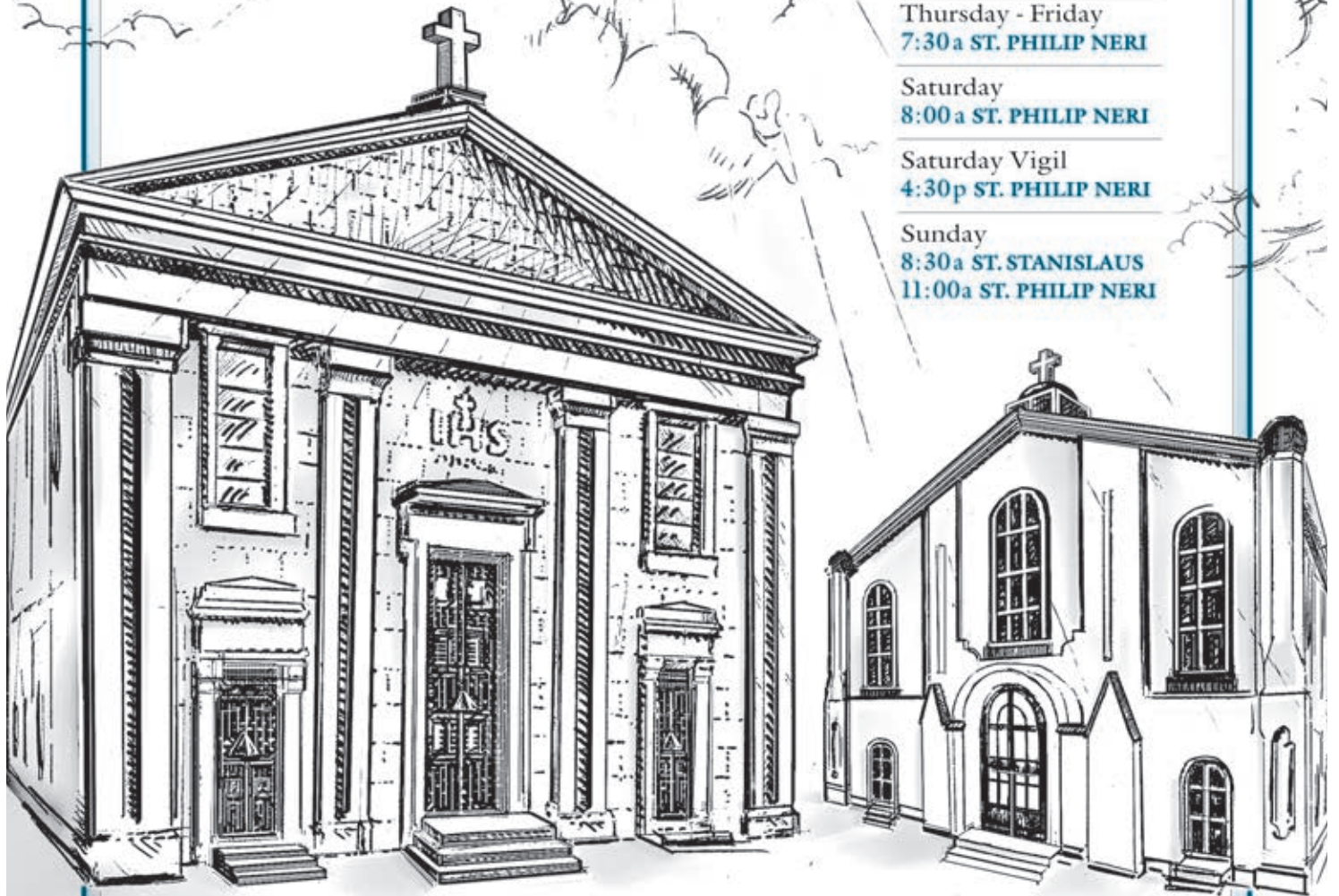

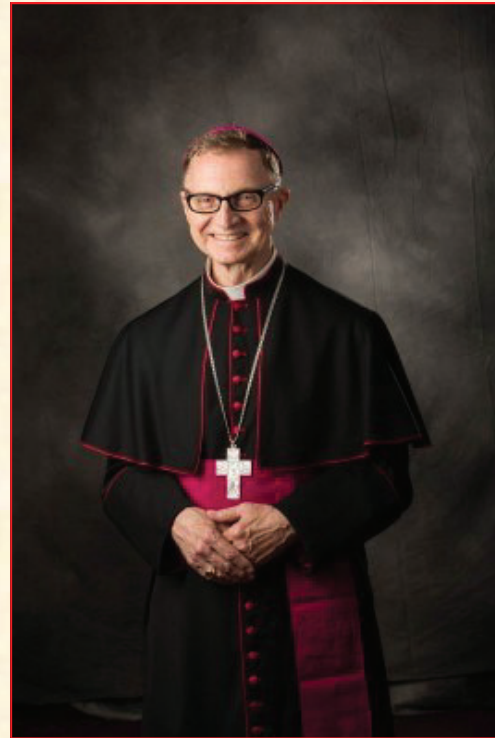

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The annual, worldwide celebration of our shared call to Mission, **World Mission Sunday**, is celebrated on **October 18, 2020** this year. That Sunday will also mark the beginning of a year-long commemoration marking the **110th Anniversary** of the *Pontifical Mission Societies* in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia.

This special year begins at a time marked by the suffering and challenges created by the coronavirus pandemic. Still, as Pope Francis reminds us, “the Missionary journey of the whole Church continues.” During the Mission Month of October, Pope Francis reminds us that, as baptized Christians, we are called personally to Mission. When the Lord ask us to respond to his call—’Whom shall I send?’ - what will your answer be? Hopefully, each of us will respond in the same way as the prophet Isaiah: **“Here I am . . . Send me.”**

“Here I Am, Send Me” is the response we can endeavor to live out throughout the *Societies’ 110th Anniversary Year-Long Celebration*. This response is displayed through our prayer, through our participation in the Eucharist and in our generosity to the **World Mission Sunday** collection for the Society for the Propagation of the Faith.

My dear Parishioners,

Today we welcome Bishop Edward Deliman, an auxiliary bishop to Archbishop Nelson Perez, to our church. He will confer the Sacrament of Confirmation to several of our young people and an adult. Confirmation is the final sacrament of Initiation (Baptism and Holy Eucharist are the other two). Perhaps you remember the Baltimore Catechism taught that we become “soldiers of Christ!” We believe that The Holy Spirit in Confirmation strengthens is to become Adults in the faith.

It is always a special time in a Church when the Bishop visits (he is a successor of the Apostles). I am so happy that Bishop Deliman cleared his Sunday schedule to be with us here this morning. Believe it or not we were in Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary together more than a few years ago.

Over the past few weeks, I have visited our shut-ins and reopened Sunday Mass at St. Stanislaus Church. We still are only getting about one-third of our usual Sunday attendance. The “good news” is that we are usually getting over two-thirds of our usual Sunday offerings.

As much as I would like to believe that we are returning to “normal”; the medical directors at Saint Monica Center assure me that we are preparing for the second wave of the pandemic. So we are certainly not ready “to let our guard down.”
