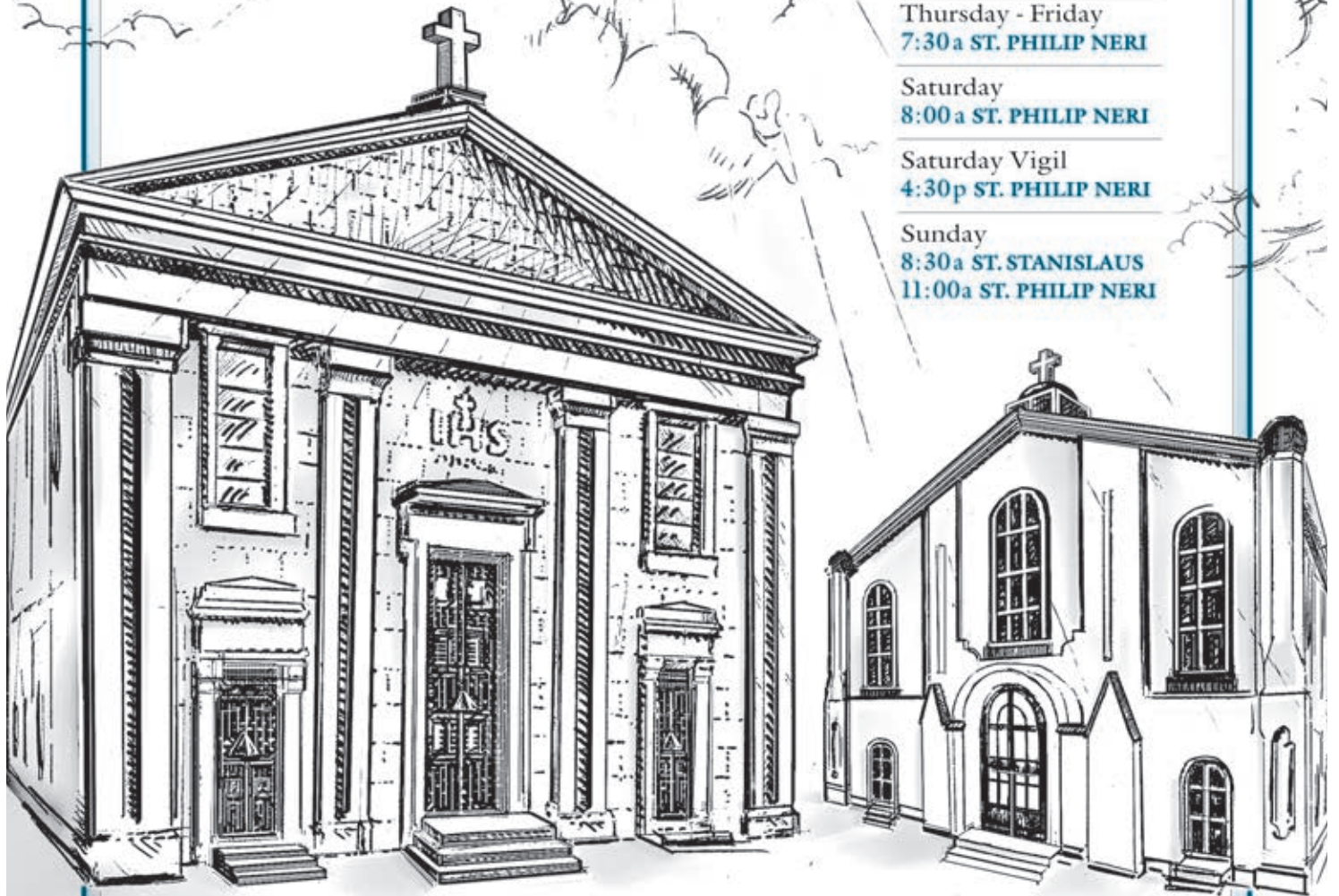

My dear Parishioners,

Last week the Pharisees tried to trip up Jesus and this week it is the Sadducees who tested Jesus by asking, “Teacher, which commandment in the law is the greatest?”

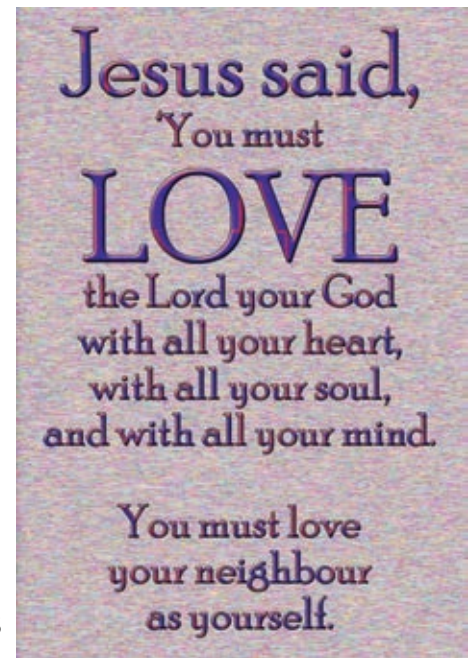
What the two groups shared was the anxiety Jesus caused in their lives, demonstrated by his popularity as teacher and healer. He captured the crowds of listeners with his clear teaching. He healed those whom society rejected, which made him a type of folk hero. He dazzled the people with his understanding of Scripture and his power to distill its meaning. His miracles were legendary as the number in his following grew, much to the consternation of the establishment. Consequently, both groups plotted how they could diminish his power base.

Both the Pharisees and the Sadducees tried to trip Jesus about his politics: Do you pay homage to Caesar? And, today: What is the greatest commandment?

Last week he used a coin of the realm; this week, the great Shema of Jewish faith: “Hear O Israel..You shall love the Lord, your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and will all your mind.” It shut them up at least for a while.

All our Scripture readings focus on our mission to spread the Word of God and God’s love to all people. May we be inspired to share God’s Word by showing God’s love to our sisters and brothers.
