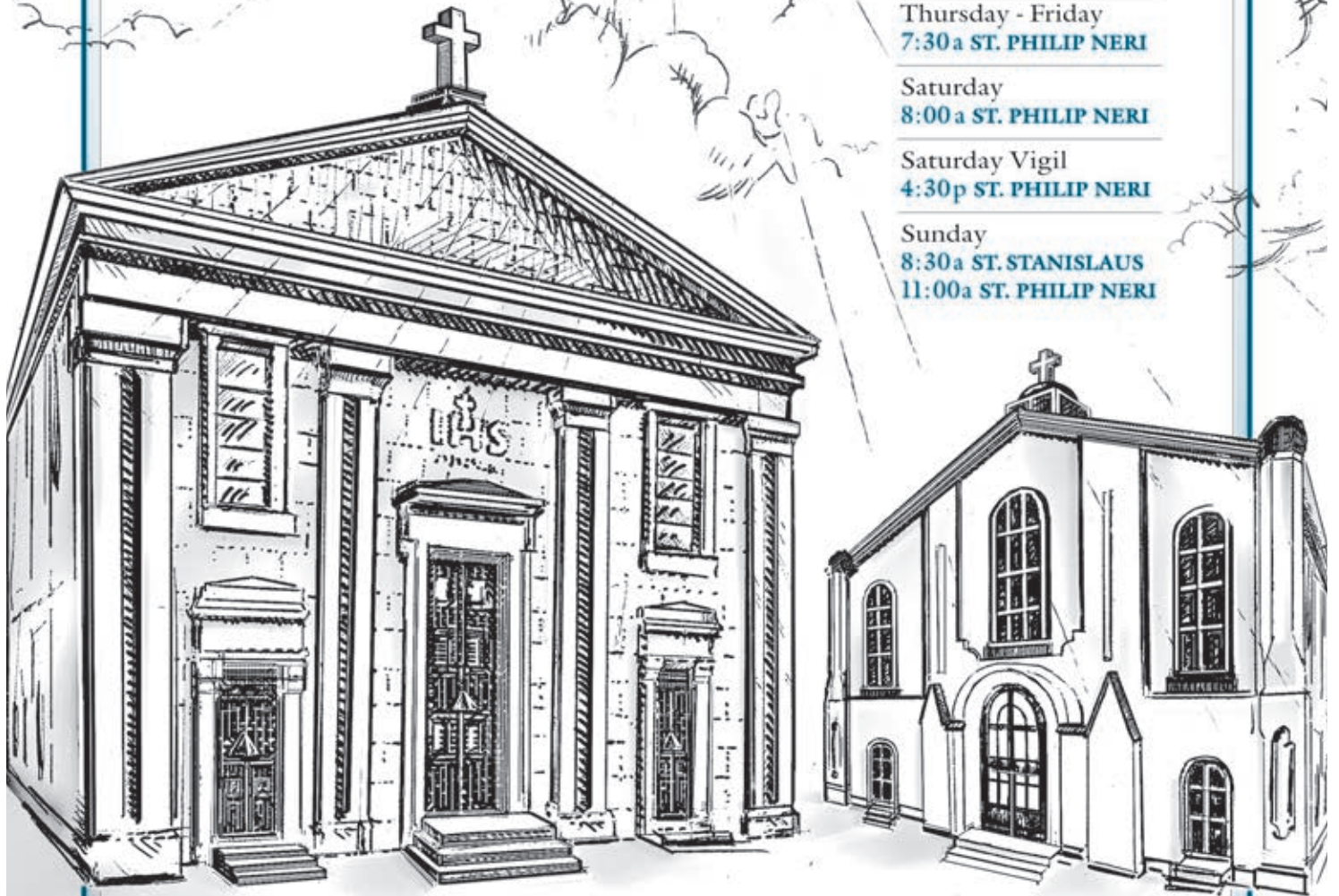

My dear Parishioners,

Christmas is much more than the celebration of the historical event of the birth of Jesus in Bethlehem. It is also the celebration of a central truth about God: that he sent his only Son to save us from our sins. It's a celebration of the incredible love of a God who "did not spare his own Son but handed him over for us all." (Romans 8:32). It's a celebration of God's deep desire to draw everyone to himself.

To help us prepare for Christmas, God invites us to spend these next 4 weeks, the season of Advent, focusing on Jesus' coming among us. But the season of Advent has a double focus. We know that it is a time to prepare for the coming of Jesus in humility as a baby. But it is also a time to look forward to the day when he will come again, this time in glory as our King.

This double focus of Advent poses a question for us. How should we live in this time between Jesus first coming and his return?

I borrowed these opening words for **Joe Difato, the publisher of The Word Among Us**, because his words succinctly express how we live these next few weeks. I am available to celebrate the **Sacrament of Penance on Sundays before Mass or by appointment.**

My prayer is that all of us will find the time to embrace Jesus and prepare the way for him in your home.
